

PLEASE READ CONDITIONS OF DUBBO NATIONAL SHEEP SHOW CAREFULLY

1. **Entry Fee:** SHOW ONLY \$33 per entry, SALE ONLY \$66 per entry, Show/Sale rams \$11 per entry. Groups and Pair \$11 (includes GST)
2. **Limit on Entries:** 5 entries per stud per class – extra entries \$55 each (includes GST).
3. All sheep to be shorn in accordance with the N.S.W.S.M.B. Association regulation as at 15th August 2008 and 1st March 2009. Only 2008 and 2009 Association ear tags will be accepted.
4. Shearing inspection certificates from all inter-state exhibitors must be presented to the Chief Steward prior to 10.00am Tuesday 25th August, 2009.
5. All sheep must be from an Accredited Brucellosis Free flock.
6. All exhibits to be Footrot Accredited Free or an owner declared certificate or a clearance certificate or a clearance certificate by a veterinary surgeon.
7. Exhibitors must collect entry cards by 10.00am Tuesday 25th August, 2009.
8. **All sheep entered for show must remain in their pens until the finish of judging unless being taken out for judging.**
9. **ALL sheep, Show and Sale must be penned by 10.00am Tuesday 25th August, 2009. A fee will be incurred by late arrivals.**
10. All Poll sheep must be inspected prior to judging and must conform to Poll definitions.
11. Sale Ram classes to include Merino and Polls to be judged together.
12. Sale Rams may be entered in the Open Section but such entries will not be eligible for Champion or Reserve Sale Ram.
13. The City of Dubbo Group may be selected from classes 1–24b and must be bred and owned by the same Registered Stud.
14. March Shorn Sale Rams are not eligible to enter in any August Shorn Classes.
15. Champion and Reserve Poll Ram and Ewe in Fine/Medium and Strong classes.
16. Champion and Reserve Poll Ram and Ewe.
17. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Ram and Ewe to be selected from all Championship winners. Not including March Shorn section.
18. Supreme Exhibit to be selected from all Championship winners. Not including March Shorn section.
19. Supreme and Groups to be judged by all judges.
20. Points for most successful exhibitor shall be awarded as follows: Single Classes, Pair, 5 Sale Rams – 1st, 2nd, 3rd; Points 3, 2, 1. Champions and Grand Champions – Points 2. Reserve Champions and Reserve Grand Champions – Points 1. City of Dubbo Group – 1st, 2nd, 3rd; Points 5, 4, 3.
21. Allocation of award ribbons: 1-6 entries, 3 ribbons; 7-11 entries, 4 ribbons; 12-15 entries, 5 ribbons; 16 and over, 7 ribbons. Group Classes – 3 ribbons.
22. It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to provide handlers for all entries.
23. All trophies and awards to be collected by 12.00noon Thursday 27th August, 2009.
24. Show only sheep can leave the Showground after 10.00am Thursday 27th August, 2009.
25. Any coat not returned will incur a charge of \$100.
26. All Poll Merino entries must be from a registered Poll Merino Stud.
27. Sheep will be judged in class where exhibitor has nominated, but the exhibitor has the right to ask the judge (via the Chief Steward) for classification prior to 10.00am Tuesday 25th August, 2009.
28. A State Representative Ram in the Supreme Exhibit cannot be entered in single classes but is eligible for pairs and groups.
29. Tax invoices will be issued after side sample results have been received.
30. All sale sheep to be weighed. Weighing will commence Wednesday 26th August, 2009 at 8.00am. Weighing will be carried out by members of the Dubbo National Ram Sale Committee.
31. All sheep entered in classes 1–53 must be bred and owned by the same registered stud.
32. It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to present for judging when called.
